<b>Cline Cellars "Ancient Vines" Zinfandel, California</b> <i>Wonderful dusty raspberry, blackberry, white pepper and spice, with coffee and chocolate characters, ripe fruit and soft tannins make this a mouth-coating rich vintage, a subtle vanilla quality that nicely complements the explosive fruit notes</i>	<b>\$12.50</b>	<b>\$47.00</b>
<b>D'Arenberg Foot Bolt Shiraz, Australia</b> <i>Rich Shiraz from Southern Australia. Great cherry and blackberry flavors followed with vanilla on the finish.</i>	<b>\$13.00</b>	<b>\$48.50</b>
<b>Lapostolle, Casa Merlot</b> <i>Clean and attractive purple violet red. Aromas hints of ripe red fruit dominate with sweet spices and notes of herbs of Provence and rosemary towards the finish.
