Napa Cellars, Zinfandel, Napa <i>The nose reveals intense, ripe berries, candies, strawberry and cinnamon. The palate follows with juicy, rounded fruit flavors that mingle with layers of warm, supple tannins</i>	\$15.00	\$60.00
