

## THE GRAND BALLROOM



The graceful ellipse of this ballroom is anchored by four majestic marble columns, suggesting a classical Greek influence. Around the ceiling, hand-painted landscapes frame a gold-leaf dome from which is suspended a six-ton Baccarat crystal chandelier. The Ballroom is encircled by a sweeping balcony where guests at pre-dinner receptions enjoy the view of decorated tables waiting below.

## THE KING ARTHUR COURT BALLROOM



An entire wall of original stained glass is a spectacular, luminous backdrop for both wedding ceremonies and dinners. This room captures the majesty of medieval Britain, with intricately carved wooden pillars, cast-iron chandeliers and a hand-painted ceiling. The King Arthur Court is a unique and colorful setting for celebration in grand style.

## THE RENAISSANCE BALLROOM



Beneath the ornately painted ceiling beams of this ballroom, celebrants are transported to an era of opulence and refinement that recalls the court of King Louis XVI of France. The walls are paneled from floor to ceiling with imported Carpathian elm burlwood, a wood so rare that it would be impossible to replace. Five Baccarat crystal chandeliers, the largest appraised at over one million dollars, illuminate the grand space, while floor to ceiling windows overlooking Michigan Avenue give the room an open, dramatic atmosphere.
